The core role of the Fiji Police Force is to maintain law and order through Protecting life and Property, Preserving peace, Preventing Offences, Detecting and Apprehending Offenders and Helping those in need of assistance. These goals outline the aspirations and directions we are committed to take in creating a safe and secure Fiji.

We exist to deliver, and understanding why we exist is critical in driving our performance culture, thus ensuring that we work in partnership with our communities to achieve our goals. I am therefore very privileged to present the Fiji Police Force's Annual Crime Statistics Report 2018.

The past year had been very promising for the Fiji Police in terms of achievements. We managed to counter overall crime and clamp it down by 2%. Similarly, sexual offences decreased by 9%, domestic violence reduced by 35%, crime against women reduced by 1%, child sexual abuse decreased by 3% and attempted suicide was decreased by 5%. We also managed to maintain our detection rate at 72%.

However, we cannot deny the fact that the Fiji Police Force like any other policing agency in the world is flanked with

monotonous challenges faced by increasing demands and emerging trends of complex criminal offences. These still challenge police as we strive to counteract with the increase in serious crime by 1%, increase crime against children by 0.3%, increase in child sexual abuse cases by 7% and the increase in suicide rate by 9%.

The DUAVATA community policing approach has enabled us to work in collaboration with government agencies, faith-based organisations and non-governmental organisations (NGOs) to create interventions and address the social ills of society. Sir Robert Peel aptly puts in Principle of Policing, number 7 "the police are the public and the public are the police". We therefore will continue to acknowledge the joint efforts of all our stakeholders in dealing with concerning issues such as domestic violence, sexual exploitation of our women and children, emergence of new drugs, youth crimes and human trafficking. We also would like to acknowledge our government's assistance and effort in ensuring that we execute our role successfully.

Concurrently, the Fiji Police continues to strengthen its technological capabilities in areas of frontline policing, investigations, mobility and communications. We will seek more new technological and scientific interventions and initiatives to ensure maximum service delivery, effective decision-making and paramount satisfaction to members of our community.

I want to thank my police men and women for their commitment and efforts which has allowed us to operate in this very challenging era and we will continue to strive towards improving service delivery towards our consumers and re-engineer our processes and systems to become a vibrant service provider in the country.

1.0 Crime statistics Interpretation

Crime statistics analysis worldwide, has remained a challenging yet critical element of decision-making to police officials. As the data collated varies and evolves around multiple factors, crafting crime data-sets is a cumbersome activity. Crimes reported on various time-lines (years) of previous occurrences are often reported in the current year. Subsequent arrests that roll-over to the following year, also has a bearing on detection rates. Likewise, the number of counts per crime offence committed also has a large impact on the percentage(s) and/or number or units of crimes committed. The Fiji Police Force [FPF] continually face these dilemmas in maintaining and reconciling crime statistics.

The Fiji Police Crime Statistics Unit has for many years become the central data collation, and analysis centre for the organization. There are however, other units within the agency, such as the Criminal Investigation Department (CID), Juvenile Bureau, and Operations Headquarters [Ops HQ] who either submit or manage data from their 'frontline' points of contact at police stations and community posts. Fiji Police crime data, are mostly classified or tagged to the definitions and classifications prescribed under the legislation such as the *Crimes Act*, *Minor Offences Act* and other relative Acts. The cycle of data collation, compilations, analysis, dissemination and storage follows the structured practices with other policing and statistics agencies.

The credibility of the Fiji Police data, remains with the absolute integrity and accuracy of human led inputs to systems or database handling automated frameworks. Minimization of human 'influence' and 'contact' post-data entry, proves significant and appraises credibility of such processes. The FPF through the Statistics Unit strives for such an intervention, where publication such as the FPF Annual Statistics Report 2017, remains a credible document, worthy of public 'consumption', record and reference.

A structured approach as to how, Fiji Police handles and converts data into meaningful decision-making tools remains essential. A summary of definitions, criteria and guidelines to the compilation of the Fiji Police Data/Statistics is mentioned hereunder.

1.1 Crime Statistics Collection

As stipulated in the Force Standing Orders [FSO], the Fiji Police Force *Annual Statistics Report* is derived under the following means:

- Receiving Reports in Police Stations [35], Community Posts [78], and other units or intra/inter-agencies which provide information and data; and
- Daily Crime Reports [DCR] - reports categorized as Crimes Registered (CR) at station level which is submitted daily from all 35 Police Stations in Fiji. These are daily occurrences of crime facts and figures that are fed from the stations to the divisional headquarters, and the Central Statistics Office at the Directorate of Planning, Police Headquarters.

1.2 Offences Classification

The data compiled in this document (Fiji Police Annual Report) is the crime data which are captured, translated and classified under the Crimes Act, 2017 (formerly Crimes Decree 2009). In this, there are 250 different offences which are classified under a cluster of five (5) major categories.

Appended below are the five (5) major categories of criminal offences:

1. Offences against the Administration of Lawful Authority (includes Treason and Other Offences against Government Authority; Other Offences against Public Order; Offences against the International Order)
2. Offences against Public Morality (includes Sexual Offences, Prostitution Offences, Abortion Offences)
3. Offences Against the Person (includes Common Assault)
4. Offences Against the Property (includes Theft, Robbery, Burglary and Fraudulent Conduct)
5. Other Miscellaneous Offences

It should be noted that there are other offences (e.g. money laundering) not classified under the Crimes Act, 2017, which are also criminal in nature and have breached other Acts such as the Financial Transaction Act, Copyright Act etc.

1.3 Reference Period

The Crime Statistics Report is prepared annually for the period from 1st January to 31st December per calendar year.

1.4 Definition of Crime

Crime is an offence, classified as an act or omission forbidden by law for which the state enacts penalty punishable by law.

1.5 Investigation

Is the search for the truth in the interest of justice and in accordance with the specifications of the Law.

1.6 Reported Offences

Reported offences are offences which are reported to the Police and appropriate entries are entered in the Complaints Register. These are the data that gets analyzed and reflected in briefs and reports such as the 'Fiji Police Annual Statistics Report'. Any other perceived information or incident occurring in the communities that are underreported does not necessarily amount to a data.

1.7 Detected Offences

All offences/ crimes are deemed to be detected under the following circumstances:

- The offender has been arrested and/or produced before a court of law, or summoned and;
- The offender has been dealt with in accordance with the laws of the land, and authority vested to the Fiji Police Force such as cautioning juveniles.

1.8 Data Source

Fiji Police Force Crime Statistics are compiled from the data received at the office from the 35 Police Stations located within the four divisions namely: Southern, Western, Eastern and Northern division.

1.9 Monitoring & Evaluation [M & E]

Fiji Police Force has a variety of Monitoring and Evaluation [M & E] methods in its Criminal Data process framework. First and foremost, the measure of performance is tagged to the institutional Annual Corporate Plan [ACP] through the Key Performance Indicator(s) [KPI]. These data form the core benchmark indicators of performance and productivity. The KPIs drive performances in personnel all throughout the year. In addition, initiated from the Planning Office, these data sets are monitored on a monthly and quarterly basis through the process of verification.

The result of achievements, shortfalls and improvement of gap areas are handed to the Commissioner of Police, who then discloses these results in his quarterly address to all members of the Fiji Police. The same is also made public through a media release. Furthermore, daily monitoring of performance based on data takes place on the bi-weekly Skype briefs from the four divisions. Finally, the Statistics Unit has also embarked on issuing weekly Bulletins in the 'Force Routine Order', a form of newsletter in the Fiji Police Force.

2.0 Disclaimer

There is no intent to discriminate, vilify or malign certain segments of our society's victim(s) and/or offender(s) of crime on ethnic, gender, age, geographical or other classification based distribution. The publisher acknowledges that these factors are sensitive in nature, however, for analysis and better demonstration of data relative to Fiji, such is portrayed in this Annual Report.

2.1 Percentage Change Formula

Please note the Percentage Change Formula:

$$\text{Percentage Change (\%)} = \left[\frac{(\text{Current Value minus Previous Value})}{(\text{Previous Value}^*)} \right] \times \frac{100}{1}$$

* If the previous value = 0, the answer will be #DIV/0! Error as its percentage, i.e., percentage change is not divisible by the number 0.

If the answer is a positive number then this is a percentage increase. If the answer is a negative number then this is a percentage decrease.

2.0 Classification of Crime Report & Interpretation

The cases in this report are stipulated in the Crimes Act (No. 44 of 2009) and are investigated by the Criminal Investigation Department, (CID), Uniform Branch (UB) personnel, other Specialised Units and Task Forces. These data excludes those offences that are also criminal in nature but are investigated and prosecuted by other agencies such as FICAC, FIRCA etc. In such cases, these crimes are not reported to police and do not form part of our data-set, and may not be the ideal reflection of the true extent of crimes in Fiji.

1. Crime Report (CR)

These are reports and complaints that are classified as offences under any Section of the Law, and may contain strong elements of prima-facie (criminality based on enough evidence) to instigate investigation and prosecution.

2. No Case In Law (NCIL)

These reports and complaints are not classified as offence(s) under any Section of the Law. However, complainants are given credible advice and guidance to explore other causes of actions, like reconciliations, generating community cohesiveness, well-being, partnerships and harmony etc.

3. Civil Cases

These are complaints which are civil in nature and can only be pursued by the complainant through civil processes. The police have no legal jurisdiction to investigate such complaints. These include seeking own legal advice through solicitors, and other legal frameworks, such as the Small Claims Tribunal etc.

4. Trivial (Trivial IR)

These are complaints which are trivial in nature and do not necessitate any formal investigation. Initial action(s) on attending these complaints are however undertaken in order to secure safety, security and harmony between the parties involved.

5. Lost & Found Property (L&FP)

These are complaints in nature of Lost and Found property and are registered under the Lost and Found Register.

6. Accident Report (AR)

These are reports of road accidents which occur on public roads in Fiji. The figures under these category are captured under the Annual Traffic Statistics Report.

7. Traffic Booking Report (TOR)

These are traffic booking cases for traffic infringements and Drunk & Drive cases.

8. Uniform Branch Report (UB)

Offences under the Crimes Act and Minor Offences Act are often investigated by the Uniform Branch personnel, and prosecuted summarily per charge and/or summon process.

9. Police Enquiry Paper (PEP)

It is a docket (police enquiry paper [file]) prepared to determine whether a case is civil or criminal in nature after an investigation is conducted. As enough evidence (prima-facie) is ascertained, the file is then converted to full criminal investigation enquiry (CR).

10. Referral To Other Stations Or Agencies

These are reports that are referred to another police station for investigation since the offence was committed within that station or court boundary/jurisdiction respectively. In other cases, there may be a core government stakeholder who may have been the rightful agency to have attended to such complaints or calls to service(s). These may include: Health, Agriculture, Customs, Welfare, Municipalities, Roads Authority, Non- governmental agencies or other essential service providers etc.

3.0 Crime Highlights - Year 2018

During the year 2018, a total of 17,728 crime cases were recorded, and registered as active police investigation files. Comparatively, in 2017, 18,128 crime cases were recorded and registered. This demonstrates a 2% decrease in crime cases when compared to 2017. Translated into raw figures, this shows a decrease of 400 crime cases.

3.1 Detection

The year 2018 recorded a 72% detection rate compared to 69% in 2017. This is an increase of 3%. There are multiple factors contributing to the rise in these figures which includes: improvement in police mobility, staff training, and higher commitment to KPIs, to name a few.

3.2 Offence Category Distribution 2018

- I. Offences against The Property (Prop) recorded 47.9% of the Total Offences;
- II. Offences against The Person (Per) recorded 29.1%;
- III. Other Offences against Crimes Act (CA) recorded 14.7%;
- IV. Offences against Public Morality (PM) recorded 5.3%;
- V. Offences against Lawful Authority (LA) recorded 2.9% and,
- VI. Offences against Other Acts recorded 0.1% of the overall offences(s).

3.3 Divisional Distribution of Crime

Table 1.0 above shows the divisional distribution of crime cases for the year 2017 and 2018.

4.0 Serious Offences

Under the Fiji Police KPIs, there are nine offences which are categorised as 'Serious Offences'. These are: (1) Rape & Attempted Rape, (2) Defilement of children under 13 years of age, (3) Defilement of young persons between 13 to 16 years of age, (4) Murder, (5) Aggravated Robbery, (6) Burglary, (7) Arson & Setting fire to crops, (8) Theft of Motor Vehicle and (9) Drug offences.

1. Rape & Attempted Rape

Rape and Attempted Rape is an offence under the Offences against the Public Morality category. The year 2018 recorded 195 Rape & Attempted Rape cases whereas the year 2017 recorded 210 cases. Comparatively, this showed a decrease of 7% (15 cases).

2. Defilement of Children Under 13 years of age (DOCU 13)

Defilement of Children under 13 years of age is an offence under the Offences against the Public Morality category. The year 2018, recorded 0 cases whereas the year 2017 recorded 5 cases. This showed a decrease of 100% (5 cases).

3. Defilement of young persons between 13 to 16 years of age (DOYPB 13-16)

Defilement of young persons between 13 to 16 years of age is an offence under the Offences against the Public Morality category. The year 2018, recorded 93 cases whereas the year 2017 recorded 94 cases. This showed a decrease of 1% (1 case).

4. Murder

Murder is an offence under the Offences against the Person category. The year 2018, recorded 16 cases whereas the year 2017 recorded 12 cases. This is an increase of 33% (4 cases).

5. Aggravated Robbery

Aggravated Robbery is an offence under the Offences against the Property category. The year 2018, recorded 471 aggravated robbery cases whereas the year 2017, recorded 501 cases. This showed a decrease of 6% (30 cases).

6. Burglary

Burglary is an offence under the Offences against the Property category. The year 2018, recorded 1,899 burglary cases whereas the year 2017, recorded 2,180 cases. This showed a decrease of 13% (281 cases).

7. Arson & Setting Fire to Crops

Arson & Setting Fire to Crops is an offence under the Offences against the Property category. The year 2018, recorded 22 cases whereas the year 2017 recorded 20 cases. This is an increase of 33% (10 cases).

8. Theft of Motor Vehicle

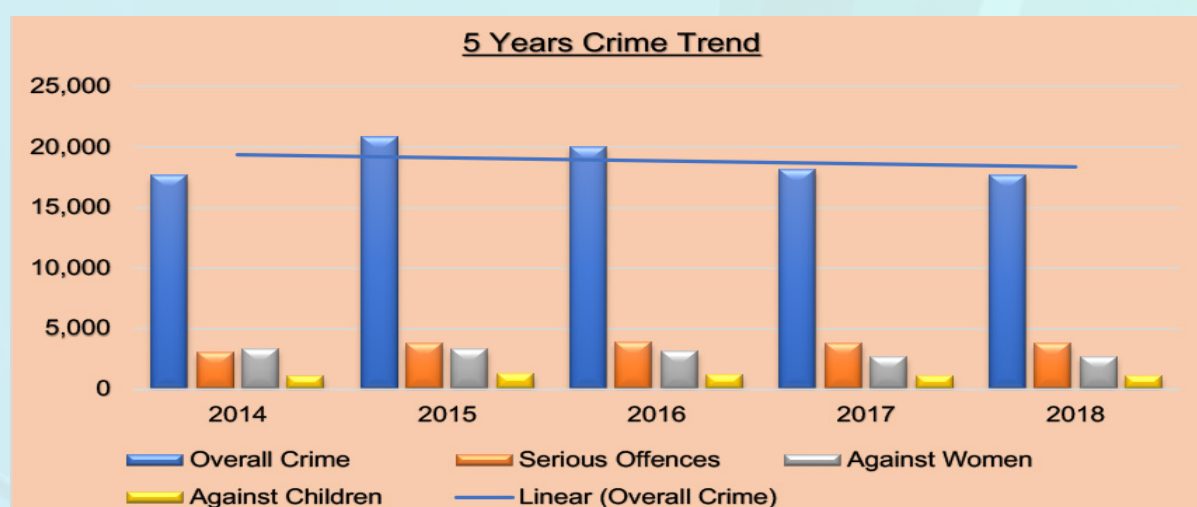
Theft of Motor Vehicle is an offence under the Offences against the Property category. The year 2018, recorded 79 cases whereas the year 2017 recorded 76 cases. This is an increase of 4% (3 cases).

9. Drugs Offences

A drug offence is an offence under the Other Offences against the Crime Act. The year 2018 recorded 1,058 drug related cases whereas the year 2017 recorded 685 cases. This showed an increase of 54% (373 cases).

The above table shows the Offence Category distribution for the years 2017 and 2018. Comparative to all categories of offences, Offences against the Property continue to be the most prevalent of the offences committed in 2018.

Overall, there was a **2% decrease in the total number of crime cases recorded in 2018** when compared to the previous year. The Offences against Lawful Authority recorded an increase of 30%, Offences against the Person recorded an increase of 2%, Other Offences against Crime Act 2009, recorded an increase of 9% and Offences Against Other Acts recorded an increase of 50%. Offences against Public Morality recorded a decrease of 9% and Offences against the Property recorded a decrease of 8% when compared to the same period in 2017.

Table 4.0: The detection rate for 2018 was 72% and it has increased by 3% when compared to 2017, which recorded 69%. The offences with a detection rate of over 90% are as follows: Bribery, Escaping from Lawful Custody, Others against Lawful Authority, Rape & Attempted Rape, Indecent Assault, Defilement of children under 13 years of age, Defilement of young persons between 13-16 years of age, Sexual Assault, Abduction of person under 18 years with intent to have carnal knowledge, Attempted Murder, Manslaughter, Infanticide, Serious Assault, Assault on Police, Others against the Person, Conversion, Fraud & False Pretense, Receiving Stolen Property, Arson & Setting fire to crops, Forgery, Currency Offences, Drugs and Money Laundering cases. There were 72% of Detected Cases and 28% of Undetected Cases during the reference period 2018 and 69% of Detected Cases and 31% of Undetected Cases for the year 2017.

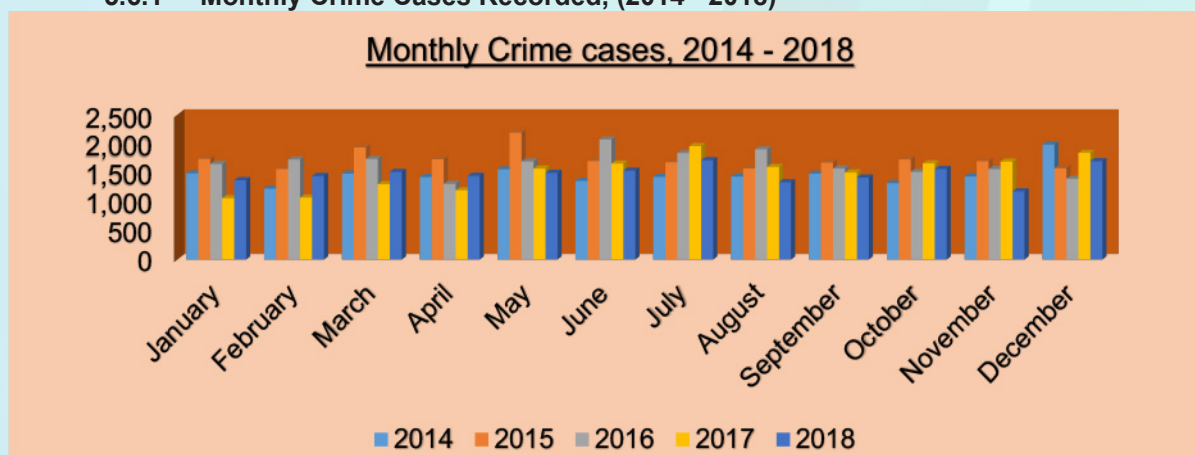

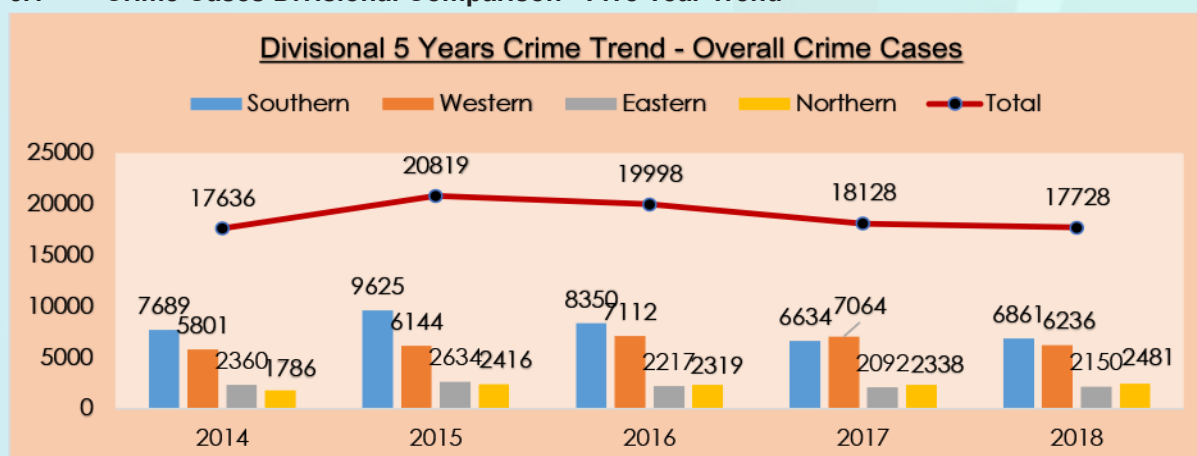

Table 7.0 shows the crime cases monthly comparison for the year 2018. The months that have recorded high crime cases in 2018 are July and December. Some prevalent offences that have recorded the highest in a particular month are mentioned as follows: Rape & Attempted rape (23 cases) in May, Defilement of young persons between 13-16 years of age (13 cases) in September, Sexual Assault (18 cases) in March, Murder (4 cases) in December, Assault causing actual bodily harm (364 cases) in December, Fraud & False Pretence (230 cases) in July, Aggravated robbery (56 cases) in April, Burglary (187 cases) in February, Theft (540 cases) in December and Drugs offence (193 cases) in September.

6.0 Divisional Crime Trend

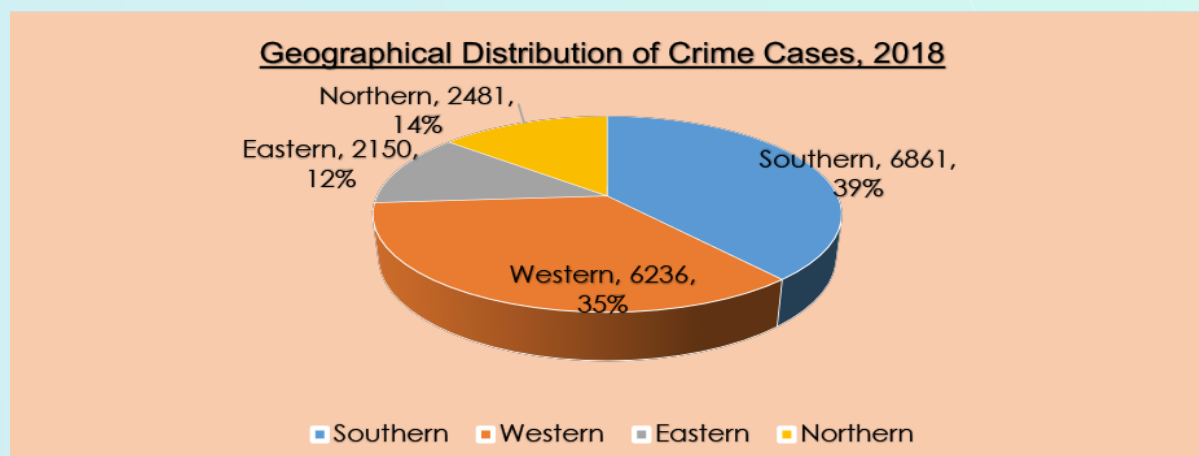
This section gives a detail examination of crime in Fiji's main divisions during the five-year period (2014-2018). The tabulations in this section contain information exclusively for each of the four (4) divisions. The Crime Statistics kept by the Fiji Police Crime Statistics Office is compiled under three hierarchies: stations, divisions and national.

6.1 Crime Cases Divisional Comparison - Five Year Trend



The Combination Chart 6.1 shows the divisional comparison of the criminal cases for the years 2014 to 2018. It is noticed that overall crime has a downward slope; indicating a decrease in crime. In the 2018, a total of 17,728 Crime cases were reported, while 2017 had 18,128 Crime cases; a decrease by 2% (a decrease by 400 crime cases). The Western division recorded a decrease of 12% while the Southern increased by 3%, Eastern increased by 3% and Northern increased by 6% in 2018 when compared to the same period in 2017.

6.2 Geographical Distribution of Crime Cases - 2018



The above pie chart shows the geographical distribution of crime cases for the year 2018. The Southern division recorded the highest with 6,861 cases (39%) followed by the Western division with 6,236 cases (35%), the Northern division with 2,481 cases (14%) and Eastern division with 2,150 cases (12%) from the overall 17,728 crime cases

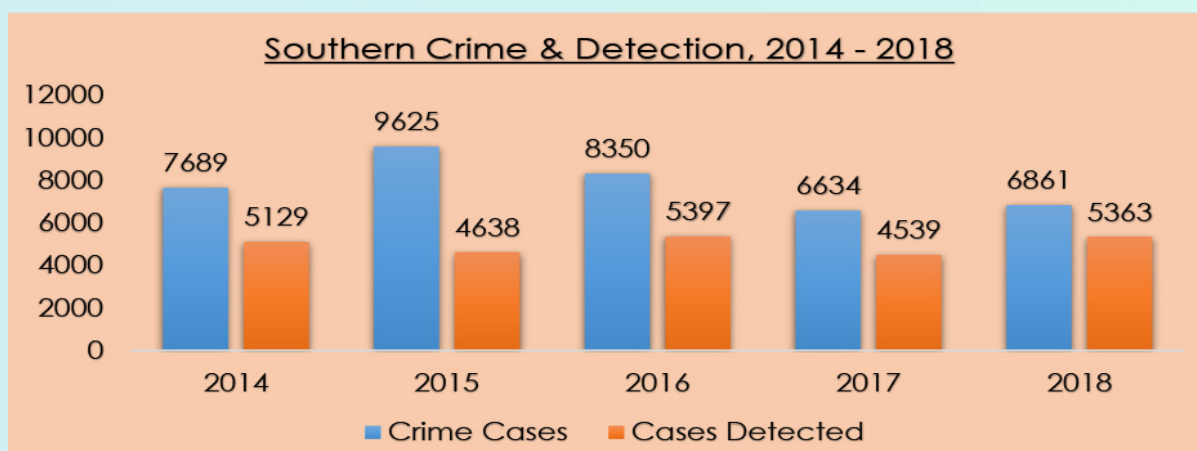

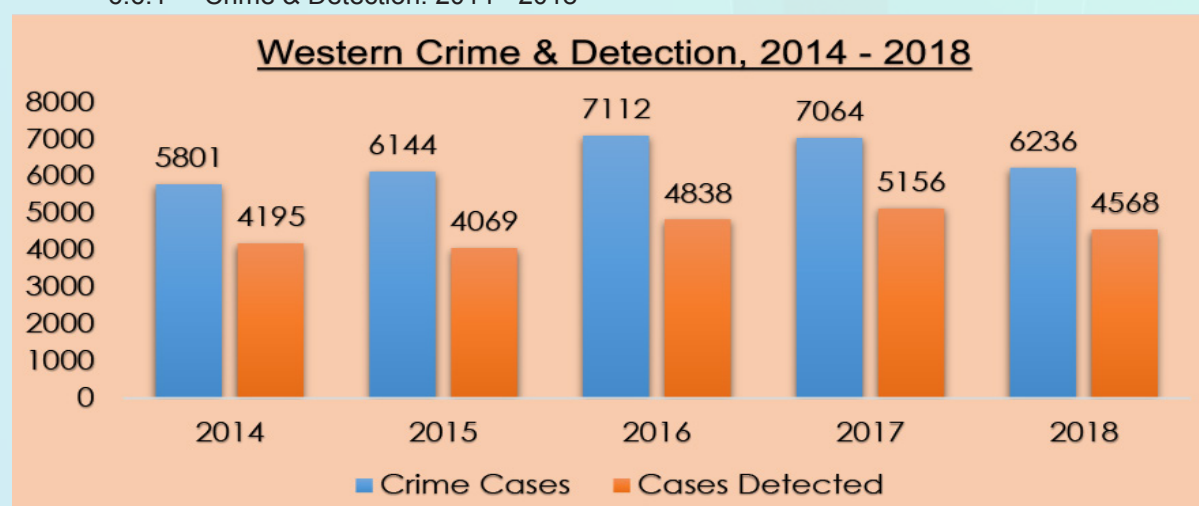

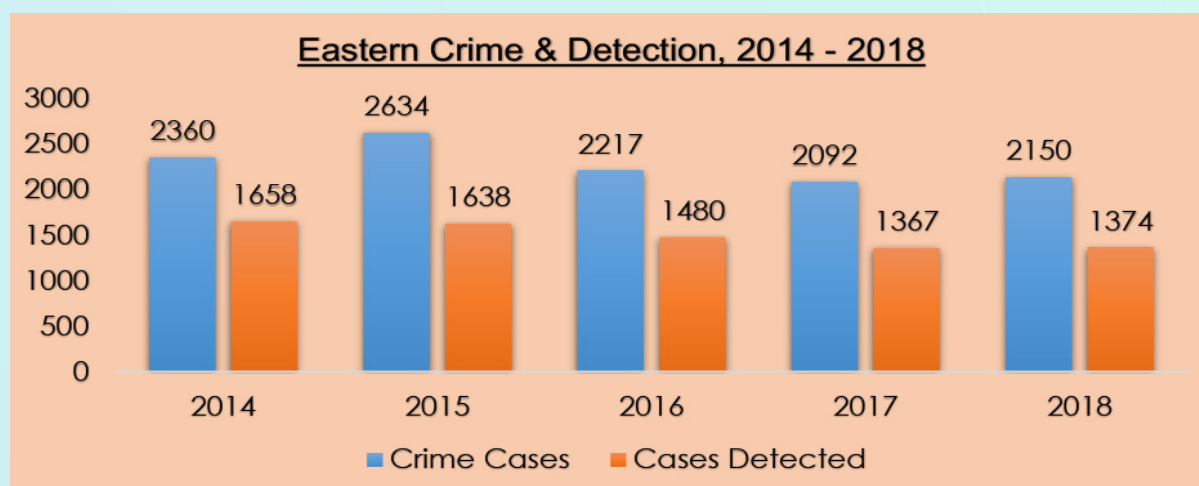

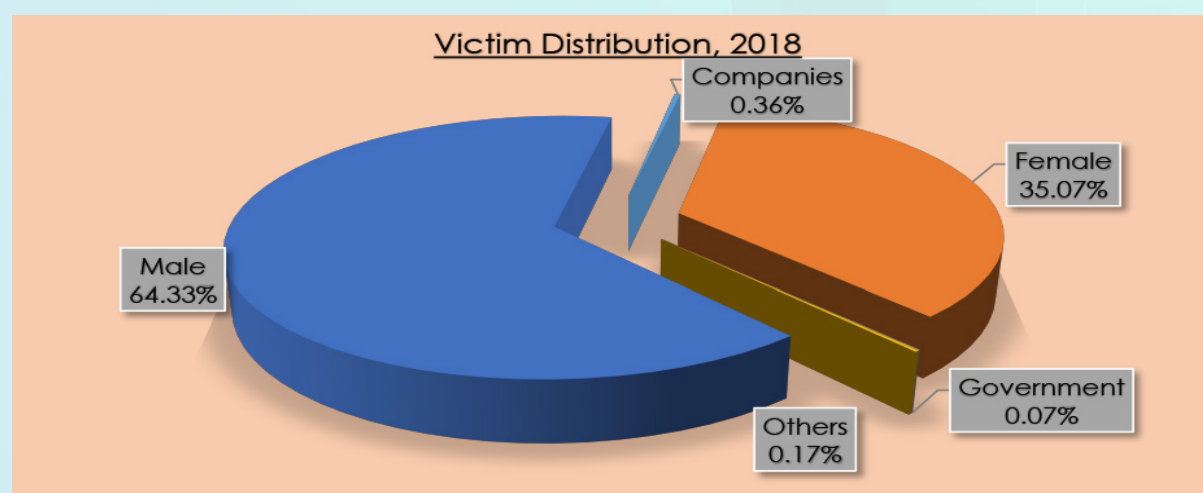
11.0 Victims

Victim(s) of crime are a pivotal determinant element of the police crime statistics. This section contains information relating to the victims of crime. They do not provide a unique victim count as one person may be counted several times if they were the victims of more than one crime.

For example, the victim of a robbery of a bank is the Banking Company rather than the teller. The number of companies, which were victims of crime, are also included and this is shown in the tables to follow.

Offender data refers to the number of offences detected through an action against an offender. As such, offender data does not equate to a unique offender count, nor does it equate to the number of offences solved. For example, an offender charged with Theft, Aggravated Robbery and Burglary would be counted three times.

Under Fiji Law, it shall be conclusively presumed that no child under the age of ten years can be guilty of any offence. Juvenile offenders are those below the ages of 18 years. Age refers to the offender's age during the time of his apprehension by police.

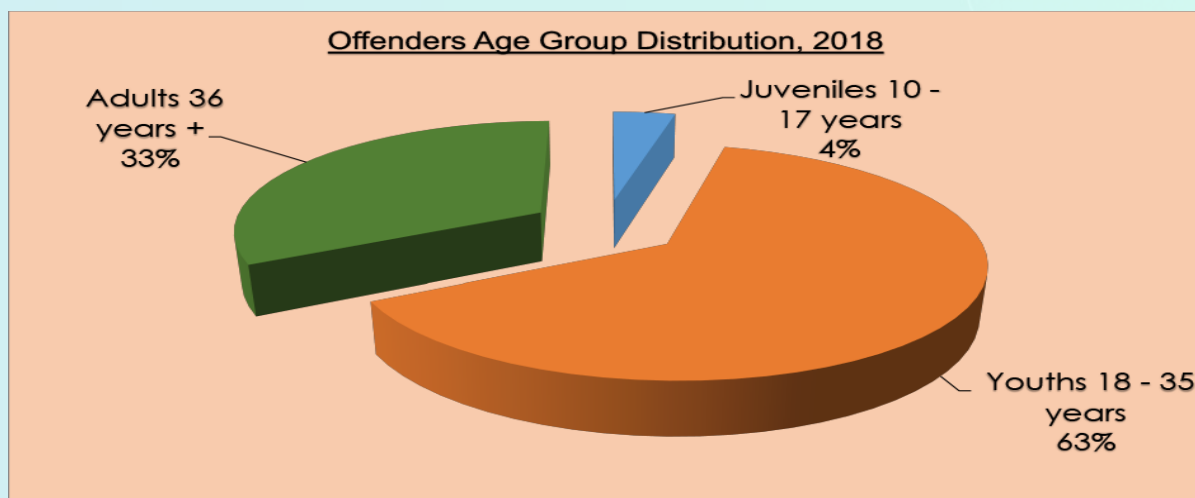

The drowning cases in Fiji have increased by 33% (11 cases) in 2018. The drowning victims are mostly from the 46 years and over category and Under 10 category. The drowning victims were mostly I-Taukei (66%), followed by Fijian of Indian descent (25%) and others (9%). From the gender category, there were 66% male victims and 34% female victims. The Western division recorded the highest in 2018 with 23 drowning cases followed by Southern with 9 cases, Eastern with 9 cases and Northern with 3 cases.
