

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COMMISSIONER'S FOREWORD

The Fiji Police Annual Crime Statistics Report for the year 2019 gives an insight of our headway and performance in pursuing our targets of maintaining law and order and in keeping our country safe.

This report outlines how crime cases under the Crimes Act 2009 are categorized. Attempt was made to capture crimes committed under other relevant legislation as police resources and efforts spread over a wide span of jurisdiction. This is further segregated by administrative divisions, prevalent offences, gender, ethnicity and some information on victims.

The number of reports made or cases registered is a crude indicator which reflects the level of safety of the nation, communities, families and individuals. The impact of crimes, can be devastating and affects the physical, psychological and emotional wellbeing of people. Crime also influences the socio-economic status and comfort of individuals, families, businesses and the economy as a whole.

Statistics plays a pivotal role in measuring our performance in the criminal front and how well we deliver our services. This includes benchmarking our performance to our crime key performance indicators which includes reducing overall crimes by 10%, reducing serious crimes by 10%, and reducing crimes against women by 10% and reducing crime against children by 10%. For the past five years, I am pleased to report that overall crimes registered a steadily decreasing trend. As for 2019, a total of 16,939 crime cases was registered when compared to 17,728 cases registered in 2018. This

is a decrease by four per cent in overall crime. Serious crimes also noted a decrease of two per cent. On the contrary, crimes against women and children recorded an increase of two per cent and five per cent respectively.

The Fiji Police remains steadfast in providing its services and attending to police reports and concerns of our women and children in society. Ongoing awareness has empowered individuals to confidently report abuse, domestic violence and sexual related cases.

The war against drugs has prompted the introduction of a specific key performance indicator to measure the number of illicit drugs registered. In 2019 the number of illicit drugs registered showed an increase of 16%. This reflects the effective push forward of resources such as drones and the efforts rendered in curbing emerging organized crime groups and illicit drug use and abuse.

Therefore, developing our capability and capacity is key to improving the successful detection, investigation and prosecution of cases. Also, the role of other enablers such as relevant legislation, technology, specialised personnel and other stakeholders such as INTERPOL and FDDU in partnership with FRCS, is commendable in filtering exclusive contrabands infiltrating our porous borders.

For a more efficient service turnover, the Fiji Police Force is currently pursuing the GIS platform for digitalizing crime data and streamlining systems and processes. This will contribute towards achieving our output in providing holistic data to internal stakeholders as this will boost statistics analysis and intelligence led operations in the front line. External stakeholders such as government departments, NGOs, Faith Based organisations, Civil Society Organisations, academic institutions, embassies and consulates, media outlets and the private sector, who have been in partnership with the Fiji police can also benefit from this data.

I sincerely thank our people, our communities, our business houses, our government departments, civil societies and regional stakeholders whose contributions have and will always have an impact on how we deliver our service and in playing their roles in keeping our Fiji safe.

1.0 CRIME STATISTICS INTERPRETATION

Crime statistics analysis worldwide has remained a challenging yet critical element of decision-making to police officials. As the data collated varies and evolves around multiple factors, crafting crime data-sets is a cumbersome activity. Crimes reported on various time-lines (years) of previous occurrences are often reported in the current year. Subsequent arrests that roll-over to the following year also has a bearing on detection rates. Likewise, the number of counts per crime offence committed also has a large impact on the percentage(s) and/or the number or units of crimes committed. The Fiji Police Force [FPF] continually face these dilemmas in maintaining and reconciling crime statistics.

The Fiji Police Crime Statistics Unit has for many years become the central data collation and analysis centre for the organization. There are however other units within the agency, such as the Criminal Investigation Department (CID), Juvenile Bureau, and Operations Headquarters [Ops HQ] who either submit or manage data from their 'frontline' points of contact at police stations and community posts. Fiji Police crime data are mostly classified or tagged to the definitions and classifications prescribed under the legislation such as the Crimes Act 2009, Minor Offences Act and other relative Acts. The cycle of data collation, compilations, analysis, dissemination, and storage follows the structured practices with other policing and statistics agencies.

The credibility of the Fiji Police data remains with the absolute integrity and accuracy of human led inputs to systems or database handling automated frameworks. Minimization of human 'influence' and 'contact' post-data entry, proves significant and appraises the credibility of such processes. The FPF through the Statistics Unit strives for such an intervention, where publication such as the FPF Annual Statistics Report 2019, remains a credible document, worthy of public 'consumption', record, and reference.

A structured approach as to how Fiji Police handles and converts data into meaningful decision-making tools remains essential. A summary of definitions, criteria, and guidelines to the compilation of the Fiji Police Data/Statistics is mentioned hereunder.

1.1 CRIME STATISTICS COLLECTION

As stipulated in the Force Standing Orders [FSO], the Fiji Police Force Annual Statistics Report is derived under the following means:

- i. Receiving Reports in Police Stations [35], Community Posts [78], and other units or intra/inter-agencies which provide information and data; and
- ii. Daily Crime Reports [DCR] reports categorized as Crimes Registered (CR) at station level which is submitted daily from all 35 Police Stations in Fiji. These are daily occurrences of crime facts and figures that are fed from the stations to the divisional headquarters, and the Central Statistics Office at the Directorate of Planning, Police Headquarters.

1.2 OFFENCES CLASSIFICATION

The data compiled in this document (Fiji Police Annual Report) are crime data captured, translated and classified under the Crimes Act 2009. In this, there are 250 different offences which are classified under a cluster of five (5) major categories.

Appended below are the five (5) major categories of criminal offences:

- 1. Offences against the Administration of Lawful Authority (includes Treason and Other Offences against Government Authority; Other Offences against Public Order; Offences against the International Order)
- 2. Offences against Public Morality (includes Sexual Offences, Prostitution Offences, Abortion Offences)
- 3. Offences Against the Person (includes Common Assault)
- 4. Offences Against the Property (includes Theft, Robbery, Burglary and Fraudulent Conduct)
- 5. Other Miscellaneous Offences

It should be noted that there are other offences (e.g. money laundering) not classified under the Crimes Act, 2009, which are also criminal in nature and have breached other Acts such as the Financial Transaction Act, Copyright Act, etc.

1.3 Reference Period

The Crime Statistics Report is prepared annually for the period from 1st January to 31st December per calendar year.

1.4 Definition of Crime

Crime is an offence, classified as an act or omission forbidden by law for which the state enacts penalty punishable by law.

1.5 Investigation

Is the search for the truth in the interest of justice and under the specifications of the law.

1.6 Reported Offences

Reported offences are offences which are reported to the Police and appropriate entries are entered in the Complaints Register. These are the data that gets analyzed and reflected in briefs and reports such as the 'Fiji Police Annual Statistics Report'. Any other perceived information or incident occurring in the communities that are underreported does not necessarily amount to a data.

1.7 Detected Offences

All offences/ crimes are deemed to be detected under the following circumstances:

- * The offender has been arrested and/or produced before a court of law, or summoned and;
- * The offender has been dealt with under the laws of the land, and authority vested to the Fiji Police Force such as cautioning juveniles.

1.8 Data Source

Fiji Police Force Crime Statistics are compiled from the data received at the office from the 35 Police Stations located within the five divisions namely: Central, Southern, Western, Eastern and Northern divisions.

1.9 Monitoring & Evaluation [M & E]

Fiji Police Force has a variety of Monitoring and Evaluation [M & E] methods in its Criminal Data process framework. First and foremost, the measure of performance is tagged to the institutional Annual Corporate Plan [ACP] through the Key Performance Indicator(s) [KPI]. These data form the core benchmark indicators of performance and productivity. The KPIs drive performances in personnel throughout the year. Also, initiated from the Planning Office, these data sets are monitored on a monthly and quarterly basis through the process of verification. The result of achievements, shortfalls, and improvement of gap areas are handed to the Commissioner of Police, who then discloses these results in his quarterly address to all members of the Fiji Police. The same is also made public through a media release. Furthermore, daily monitoring of performance based on data takes place on the bi-weekly Skype briefs from the four divisions. Finally, the Statistics Unit has also embarked on issuing weekly Bulletins in the 'Force Routine Order', a form of newsletter in the Fiji Police Force.

2.0 Disclaimer

There is no intent to discriminate, vilify or malign certain segments of our society's victim(s) and/or offender(s) of crime on ethnicity, gender, age, geographical or other classification based distribution. The publisher acknowledges that these factors are sensitive in nature, however, for analysis and better demonstration of data relative to Fiji, such is portrayed in this Annual Report.

2.1 Percentage Change Formula

Please note the Percentage Change Formula:

Percentage Change (%) =
$$(Current \ Value \ minus \ Previous \ Value) \times 100 / (Previous \ Value*)$$

If the answer is a positive number then this is a percentage increase. If the answer is a negative number then this is a percentage decrease.

^{*} If the previous value = 0, the answer will be **#DIV/0!** Error as its percentage, i.e., percentage change is not divisible by the number 0.

2.0 CLASSIFICATION OF CRIME REPORT & INTERPRETATION

The cases in this report are stipulated in the Crimes Act 2009 and are investigated by the Criminal Investigation Department, (CID), Uniform Branch (UB) personnel, other Specialised Units, and Task Forces. These data exclude those offences that are also criminal in nature but are investigated and prosecuted by other agencies such as FICAC, FIRCA, etc. In such cases, these crimes are not reported to the police and do not form part of our data-set, and may not be the ideal reflection of the true extent of crimes in Fiji.

1. Crime Report (CR)

These are reports and complaints that are classified as offences under any Section of the Law and may contain strong elements of prima-facie (criminality based on enough evidence) to instigate investigation and prosecution.

2. No Case In Law (NCIL)

These reports and complaints are not classified as offence(s) under any Section of the Law. However, complainants are given credible advice and guidance to explore other causes of actions, like reconciliations, generating community cohesiveness, well-being, partnerships, and harmony, etc.

3. Civil Cases

These are complaints that are civil in nature and can only be pursued by the complainant through civil processes. The police have no legal jurisdiction to investigate such complaints. These include seeking own legal advice through solicitors, and other legal frameworks, such as the Small Claims Tribunal, etc.

4. Trivial (Trivial IR)

These are complaints that are trivial in nature and do not necessitate any formal investigation. Initial action(s) on attending these complaints are however undertaken in order to secure safety, security, and harmony between the parties involved.

Lost & Found Property (L&FP)

These are complaints like Lost and Found property and are registered under the Lost and Found Register.

6. Accident Report (AR)

These are reports of road accidents that occur on public roads in Fiji. The figures under this category are captured under the Annual Traffic Statistics Report.

7. Traffic Booking Report (TOR)

These are traffic booking cases for traffic infringements and Drunk & Drive cases.

8. Uniform Branch Report (UB)

Offences under the Crimes Act and Minor Offences Act are often investigated by the Uniform Branch personnel, and prosecuted summarily per charge and/or summon process.

9. Police Enquiry Paper (PEP)

It is a docket (police enquiry paper [file]) prepared to determine whether a case is civil or criminal in nature after an investigation is conducted. As enough evidence (prima-facie) is ascertained, the file is then converted to full criminal investigation enquiry (CR).

10. Referral To Other Stations Or Agencies

These are reports that are referred to another police station for investigation since the offence was committed within that station or court boundary/jurisdiction respectively. In other cases, there may be a core government stakeholder who may have been the rightful agency to have attended to such complaints or calls to service(s). These may include: Health, Agriculture, Customs, Welfare, Municipalities, Roads Authority, Non-governmental agencies or other essential service providers etc.

3.0 CRIME HIGHLIGHTS - YEAR 2019

The year 2019 has a total of 16,939 crime cases that were recorded and registered as active police investigation files. Comparatively, in 2018, 17,728 crime cases were recorded and registered. This demonstrates a 4% decrease in crime cases when compared to 2018. When translated into raw figures, this shows a decrease of 789 crime cases.

3.1 Detection

A 68% detection rate was recorded in 2019 when compared to 72% in 2018.

3.2 Offence Category Distribution 2019

- I. Offences against The Property (Prop) recorded 46.61% of the Total Offences,
- II. Offences against The Person (Per) recorded 30.97%,
- III. Other Offences against Crimes Act (CA) recorded 6.72%,
- IV. Offences against Public Morality (PM) recorded 4.91%,
- V. Offences against Lawful Authority (LA) recorded 3.57% and,
- VI. Offences against Other Acts recorded 7.22% of the overall offences(s).

3.3 Divisional Distribution of Crime

Table 1.0 above shows the divisional distribution of crime cases for the year 2018 and 2019.

4.0 SERIOUS OFFENCES

Under the Fiji Police Key Performance Indicators, there are eight offences which are categorised as 'Serious Offences'. These are: (1) Rape & Attempted Rape, (2) Defilement of children under 13 years of age, (3) Defilement of young persons between 13 to 16 years of age, (4) Murder, (5) Aggravated Robbery, (6) Burglary, (7) Arson & Setting fire to crops and (8) Theft of Motor Vehicle.

1. Rape & Attempted Rape

Rape and Attempted Rape is an offence under the Offences against the Public Morality category. The year 2019 recorded 250 Rape & Attempted Rape cases whereas the year 2018 recorded 195 cases. Comparatively, this showed an increase of 28% (55 cases).

2. Defilement of Children Under 13 years of age (DOCU 13)

The Defilement of Children under 13 years of age is an offence under 'Offences against the Public Morality' category. The year 2019, recorded 3 cases whereas the year 2018 recorded 0 cases, an increase of 3 cases.

3. Defilement of young persons between 13 to 16 years of age (DOYPB 13-16)

The Defilement of young persons between 13 to 16 years of age is an offence under 'Offences against the Public Morality' category. The year 2019, recorded 80 cases whereas the year 2018 recorded 93 cases. This showed a decrease of 14% (13 cases).

4. Murder

Murder is an offence under 'Offences against the Person' category. The year 2019, recorded 26 cases whereas the year 2018 recorded 16 cases. This is an increase of 63% (10 cases).

5. Aggravated Robbery

Aggravated Robbery is an offence under 'Offences against the Property' category. The year 2019, recorded 446 aggravated robbery cases whereas the year 2018, recorded 471 cases. This is a decrease of 5% (25 cases).

6. Burglary

Burglary is an offence under 'Offences against the Property' category. A total of 1,837 burglary cases were recorded in 2019 while 1,899 cases was recorded in 2018. This is a decrease of 3% (62 cases).

7. Arson & Setting Fire to Crops


Arson & Setting Fire to Crops is an offence under 'Offences against the Property' category. While the year 2018 recorded 22 cases, the year 2019 recorded 17 cases. This is a decrease of 23% (5 cases).

8. Theft of Motor Vehicle

Theft of Motor Vehicle is an offence under 'Offences against the Property' category. The year 2019, recorded 68 cases while the year 2018 recorded 79 cases. This is a decrease of 14% (11 cases).

5.0 **SUMMARY**

5.1 Crime Key Performance Indicators (KPI)



The table above shows the 5 years crime Key Performance Indicators. The FPF has made achievements in its Key Performance Indicators (KPI) as follows: 4% decrease in overall crimes and 2% decrease in serious crime. However, there is a 2% increase in crime against women and 5% increase in crime against children

The above table shows the Offence Category distribution for the years 2018 and 2019. Offences against the Property continue to be the most prevalent of the offences committed in 2019.

Overall, there was a **4% decrease in the total number of crime cases recorded in 2019** when compared to the previous year. Offences against Lawful Authority recorded an increase of 17%, Offences against the Person recorded an increase of 2% and, Other Offences against Other Acts recorded an increase of 15%. Other categories recorded

decreases and these include a 12% in Offences against Public Morality, 7% in Offences against the Property and, 26% in Offences against Crime Act when compared to the same period in 2018.

Table 4.0: The detection rate for 2019 was 68% and it has decreased by 4% when compared to 2018, which recorded 72%. The offences with a detection rate of over 90% are as follows: Bribery, Escaping from Lawful Custody, Others against Lawful Authority, Rape & Attempted Rape, Indecent Assault, Defilement of young persons between 13-16 years of age, Sexual Assault, Abduction of person under 18 years with intent to have carnal knowledge, Murder, Manslaughter, Infanticide, Serious Assault, Unlawful Wounding, Conversion, Fraud & False Pretense, Receiving Stolen Property, Forgery, Currency Offences and Drugs cases. There was a 68% of detected cases and 32% undetected cases during the year 2019, whilst a 72% detected cases and 28% undetected cases was recorded for the year 2018.





Table 7.0 shows the monthly comparison of crime cases for the year 2019. The months that have recorded high crime cases are July and December. Other prevalent offences recorded during the year include Rape & Attempted rape (39 cases) in March, Defilement of young persons between 13-16 years of age (13 cases) in May, Sexual Assault (14 cases) in July, Murder (5 cases) in September, Assault causing actual bodily harm (342 cases) in April, Fraud & False Pretence (123 cases) in March, Aggravated robbery (57 cases) in June, Burglary (212 cases) in April, Theft (429 cases) in September and Drugs offence (192 cases) in September.

6.0 DIVISIONAL CRIME TREND


This section gives a detail examination of crime in Fiji's five main policing divisions during the five-year period (2015-2019). The crime statistics kept by the Fiji Police Crime Statistics Office is compiled under three hierarchies: stations, divisions and national.

6.1 Crime Cases Divisional Comparison - Five Year Trend



The Combination chart 6.1 shows the divisional comparison of the criminal cases for the years 2015 to 2019. The crime trend shows a downward slope indicating a decrease. In 2019, a total of 16,939 crime cases were reported, while 2018 had 17,728 crime cases; a decrease of 4% (a decrease by 789 crime cases). The Southern division recorded a decrease of 11%, Northern division recorded a decrease of 7% and Central division recorded a decrease of 24% while the Western division showed an increase of 2%. The Eastern recorded an increase of 10% when compared to the same period in 2018.

6.2 Geographical Distribution of Crime Cases - 2019



The above pie chart shows the geographical distribution of crime cases for the year 2019. From the overall 16,939 crime cases, the Western division recorded the highest with 6,367 cases (38%) followed by the Southern division with 4,785 cases (28%), the Northern division with 2,315 cases (14%), Eastern division with 2,359 cases (14%) and Central division with 1,113 cases (6%).





The year 2019 reported a total of 530 cases of child sexual abuse. This is an increase of 7% when compared to the same period the previous year which recorded 567 cases. The age group that recorded the highest in the 13 to 17-year-olds with 358 cases followed by 6 to 12-year-olds with 144 cases and less than and equal to 5-year-olds with 28 cases. The 13 to 17-year-old child victims of sexual abuse recorded a decrease of 11% from the year 2018 to 2019.

Offences such as Rape, Indecent assault, Sexual assault, Defilement of young persons between 13 years and 16 years of age, and Abduction of a person under 18 years of age with intent to have carnal knowledge continues to be the most prevalent form of sexual offence committed against children.



Offender data refers to the number of offences detected through an action against an offender. As such, offender data does not equate to a unique offender count, nor does it equate to the number of offences solved. For example, an offender charged with Theft, Aggravated Robbery and Burglary would be counted three times.

Under Fiji Law, it shall be conclusively presumed that no child under the age of ten years can be guilty of any offence. Juvenile offenders are those below the ages of 18 years. Age refers to the offender's age during the time of his apprehension by police.



The drowning cases in Fiji have increased by 5% (2 cases) in 2019. The victims who died by drowning are mostly from the 46 years and over category and Under 10 years category. The victims were mostly iTaukei (65%), followed by Fijian of Indian descent (22%) and others (13%). From the gender category, there were 78% male victims and 22% female victims. The Western division recorded the highest in 2019 with 17 drowning cases followed by Eastern with 15 cases, Northern with 8 cases and Southern & Central with 3 cases each.
